Supreme Court ruled the President "didn't have absolute, unqualified privilege to withhold information," as part of a case investigating the President. Nixon, the President, resigned.



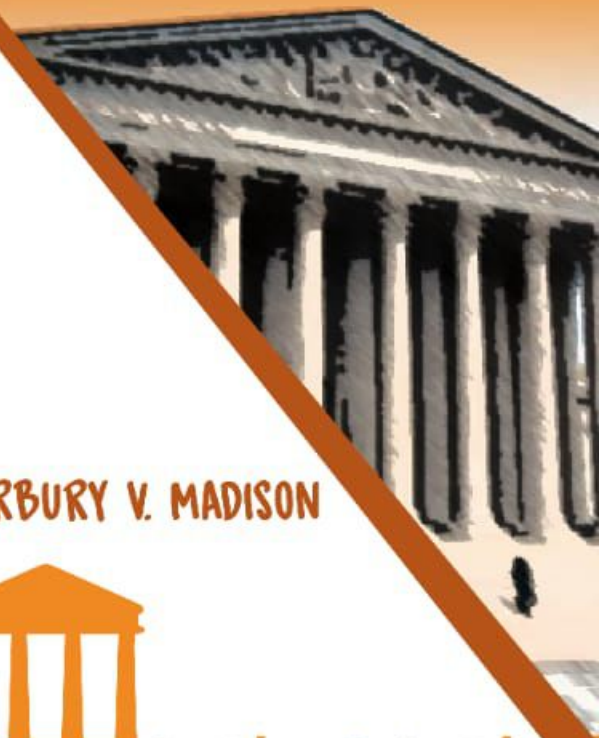
CITIZENS UNITED V. FEDERAL ELECTION COMMISSION

Allowed all organizations from nonprofits to make donation to political people and movements. This allowed money to have more influence in politics.
